<u>Purpose</u> The fund is a depository for funds allocated for state administrative and engineering support required for the implementation and administration of the state disaster assistance program authorized under this chapter or for other assistance deemed necessary to carry out the requirements of this chapter, as specified.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Office of Emergency Services/Org 0690		
<u>Major Revenue Sources</u> An appropriation by the Legislature will provide that the Account have an unencumbered balance of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) at the beginning of each fiscal year.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> For state administrative and engineering support required for the implementation and administration of the state disaster assistance program authorized under Chapter 1507/88, or other assistance deemed necessary to carry out the requirements of this chapter, as specified.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 8690.4 of the Government Code provides that it is the intent of the Legislature that the Account have an unencumbered balance of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) at the beginning of each fiscal year. In addition, in the event that the account requires additional moneys to meet claims against the account, the Director of Finance may transfer moneys from the Special Fund for Economic Uncertainties to the account in that amount sufficient to pay the amount of the claims exceeding the unencumbered balance in the account, provided that the transfer is not made sooner than 30 days after notification in writing of the necessity therefor is provided to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded.
