<u>Legal Title</u> Electronic and Appliance Repair Fund		
<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Chapter 18, Statutes of 2009-2010 (AB 20XXXX) Business and Professions Code sections 9870

<u>Purpose</u> For the deposit of fees collected from licensed service dealers under the Electronic Repair Dealer Registration Law. The fund is used for the payment of expenses of the bureau in carrying out its responsibilities of licensing and regulating persons or businesses engaged in installing, repairing, servicing or maintaining electronic appliances used in homes or motor homes. The Electronic and Appliance Repair Dealer Registration Law specifically exempted the repair, service or maintenance of equipment used in commercial, industrial, or governmental establishments and the repair, service or maintenance of equipment which in its ordinary use requires a license or permit issued by the Federal Communications Commission.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Consumer Affairs - Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Registration and renewal fees and penalties.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 9872 of the Business and Professions Code appropriates the Electronic and Appliance Repair to carry out the provisions of this chapter.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded- Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 1492, Statutes of 1963 added the fund. Chapter 716, Statutes of 1971 changed the name of the fund to the Repair Services Fund and the administering agency to the Bureau of Repair Services. Chapter 1161, Statutes of 1978 changed the name of the fund to its present name and the administering agency to the Bureau of Electronic and Appliance Repair.		

Chapter 74, Statutes of 2005 (AB 139) substituted “shall be used” for “is hereby continuously appropriated”.
