<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To develop, establish, and operate a program to issue vessel operator card to persons passing a vessel operator examination or vessel operator course.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Parks and Recreation/Org 3790		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation from the Legislature pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code section 678.3 (d).		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Initially, to develop the program a \$4 million loan will be transferred from the Harbors and Watercraft Revolving Fund (0516) pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code section 678.7.
