<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To provide health insurance coverage for qualified high risk pools in accordance with Insurance Code section 12739.5 through 12739.76.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Transfer from the Federal Trust Fund pursuant to Insurance Code section 12739.755.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, this fund is continuously appropriated.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted or will be counted in an included or always excluded fund and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Pursuant to Insurance Code section 12739.76, this fund shall remain in effect only until January 1, 2020, and as of that is repealed, unless a later enacted statute deletes or extends it. Chapter 31, Statutes of 2014 (SB 857) changed the administering agency from Managed Risk Medical Insurance Board/Org 4280 to Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260 effective July 1, 2014.
