<u>Purpose</u> This fund was created as a depository for the transfer of money from both state funds and non-state sources available for the construction, alteration, repair, and improvement of trial and appellate court buildings, including, but not limited to, services, new construction, major construction, minor construction, maintenance, improvements, and equipment, and other building and improvement projects as authorized by the Administrative Office of the Courts, and approved by the Department of Finance, as specified.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Judicial Branch/Org 0250		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfer of money from both state funds and non-state sources.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 70379 (b), any amount available in the state appropriation that is in excess of the amount necessary based upon final actual costs of the completed contract shall be transferred immediately to the credit of the fund from which the appropriation was made.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Notwithstanding Section 13340 of the Government Code, this fund is continuously appropriated, without regard to fiscal years.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Working Capital and Revolving Fund.
