An act to amend Section 8754 of the Government Code, relating to state government.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 8754 of the Government Code is amended to read:

8754. The council Governor shall select appoint a director for the Arts Council. The council may delegate to the director the responsibilities for carrying out council policy.

The director shall assist the council in the carrying out of its work, be responsible for the hiring of council staff, including, but not limited to, deputy directors, be responsible for the management and administration of the council staff, and perform other duties as directed by the council.

General Subject: Arts Council: director: appointment.

Existing law, the Dixon-Zenovich-Maddy California Arts Act of 1975, establishes an Arts Council that has specified duties related to the arts. Existing law requires the council to select a director and authorizes the council to delegate certain responsibilities to the director.

This bill would instead require the Governor to appoint the director of the Arts Council.
