An act to amend Section 1567.70 of the Health and Safety Code, and to amend Sections 4684.82 and 4684.87 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to developmental services.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 1567.70 of the Health and Safety Code is amended to read:

1567.70. This article shall remain in effect only until January 1, ~~2020~~, 2021, and as of that date is repealed, unless a later enacted statute, that is enacted before January 1, ~~2020~~, 2021, deletes or extends that date.

SEC. 2. Section 4684.82 of the Welfare and Institutions Code is amended to read:

4684.82. The vendoring regional center shall, before placing any consumer into an enhanced behavioral supports home, ensure that the home has a license issued by the State Department of Social Services for not more than four individuals with developmental disabilities, is certified by the State Department of Developmental Services, and has a contract with the regional center that meets the contracting requirements established by the State Department of Developmental Services through regulations promulgated pursuant to this article. Under no circumstances shall the contract extend beyond the stated termination date, which shall not be longer than January 1, ~~2020~~, 2021.

SEC. 3. Section 4684.87 of the Welfare and Institutions Code is amended to read:

4684.87. This article shall remain in effect only until January 1, ~~2020~~, 2021, and as of that date is repealed, unless a later enacted statute, that is enacted before January 1, ~~2020~~, 2021, deletes or extends that date.



## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

General Subject: Enhanced behavioral supports homes.

The Lanterman Developmental Disabilities Services Act makes the State Department of Developmental Services responsible for providing various services and supports to individuals with developmental disabilities and for ensuring the appropriateness and quality of those services and supports. Under existing law, the State Department of Social Services licenses community care facilities, including adult residential facilities or group homes that serve persons with developmental disabilities.

Existing law requires the State Department of Developmental Services to certify, and the State Department of Social Services to license, until January 1, 2020, enhanced behavioral supports homes, which are adult residential facilities or group homes that provide 24-hour nonmedical care to individuals with developmental disabilities who require enhanced behavioral supports, staffing, and supervision in a homelike setting, and that are eligible for federal Medicaid funding.

This bill would extend the operation of these provisions until January 1, 2021, and would make conforming changes.
