Subject: Housing Assets Transfer Form

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34176 (a) (2), the City of Fillmore (City) submitted a Housing Assets Transfer Form (Form) to the California Department of Finance (Finance) on August 6, 2012 for the period February 1, 2012 through August 6, 2012.

HSC section 34176 (e) defines a housing asset. Assets transferred deemed not to be a housing asset shall be returned to the successor agency. Finance requested that the City provide information that would justify the transfer of assets. To date, the City has not provided any information and Finance is unable to determine the appropriateness of the transfers of the assets listed on your Form. As such, Finance is objecting to all assets listed on your Form.

Please provide pertinent information to demonstrate that items listed on the Form are for low and moderate income housing purposes. The information should be provided to Finance during the Meet and Confer process which should be requested within five business days of receiving this letter.
