Dear Mr. Jansons:

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34177 (l) (2) (C), the City of Hemet Successor Agency submitted a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) to the California Department of Finance (Finance) on April 12, 2012.

HSC Section 34177 (l) (3) states that the first ROPS shall be for the period of January 1, 2012 to June 30, 2012, inclusive. The March 2, 2012 letter from Ana Matosantos (Director of Department of Finance) states the same information. The intention is that the time frame for the ROPS will be comparable to the time frame for tax increment revenues, which are received for the period January through June and then July through December. Please resubmit your ROPS for the period January through June 2012.

As authorized by HSC section 34179 (h), Finance is returning your ROPS for your reconsideration. This action will cause the specific ROPS items noted above to be ineffective until Finance approval. Furthermore, items listed on future ROPS will be subject to review and may be denied as EOs.
