Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34177 (l) (2) (C), the City of Morgan Hill Successor Agency submitted a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) to the California Department of Finance (Finance) on April 18, 2012 for the period January through June 2012.
