Dear Mr. Lambert:

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34177 (l) (2) (C), the San Buenaventura Successor Agency (Agency) submitted a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) to the California Department of Finance (Finance) on April 27, 2012 for the period January through June 2012 and July through December 2012. Finance staff contacted you for clarification of items listed in the ROPS.

HSC section 34171 (d) lists enforceable obligation (EO) characteristics. Based on a sample of line items reviewed and application of the law, the following do not qualify as EOs:

January – June 2012 ROPS:

- Form A, item 5 – Advances/Cooperation Agreement in the amount of \$5.4 million. HSC section 34171 (d) (2) states that loans between the entity that created the redevelopment agency (RDA) and the former RDA are only enforceable if made within the first two years of the RDA's existence.
- Form A, item 18- Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$40,000. HSC section 34163 (c) states the agency shall not have the authority to amend or modify existing agreements after June 27, 2011.
- Form A, item 19 – Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$60,000. This agreement is between the City of Ventura and the Housing Authority – not the RDA.
- Administrative cost claimed exceeds allowance by \$14,270. HSC section 34171 (b) limits administrative expenses to five percent of property tax allocated to the successor agency or \$250,000, whichever is greater. The administrative cost calculation is shown in Attachment A.

July – December 2012 ROPS:

- Form A, item 5 – Advances/Cooperation Agreement in the amount of \$4.9 million. HSC section 34171 (d) (2) states that loans between the entity that created the RDA and the

former RDA are only enforceable if made within the first two years of the RDA's existence.

- Form A, item 18- Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$38,000. HSC section 34163 (c) states the agency shall not have the authority to amend or modify existing agreements after June 27, 2011.

As authorized by HSC section 34179 (h), Finance is returning your ROPS for your reconsideration. This action will cause the specific ROPS items noted above to be ineffective until Finance approval. Furthermore, items listed on future ROPS will be subject to review and may be denied as EOs.

If you believe we have reached this conclusion in error, please provide further evidence that the items questioned above meet the definition of an EO and send to the following email address:

Finance may continue to review items on the ROPS in addition to those mentioned above and identify additional issues. We will provide separate notice if we are requesting further modifications to the ROPS. It is our intent to provide an approval notice with regard to each ROPS prior to the June 1 property tax distribution date.
