

Legal Immigration to California in 2001

This report highlights attributes of the immigrants granted legal permanent residence by the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) in 2001. A more complete analysis of recent immigrants is included in the companion report: *They Came to California: Legal Immigration in 2000*.

Highlights of the 2001 Data:

- ✘ The United States became home to more than one million immigrants in 2001. There was also a backlog of nearly a million adjustments of status applications still pending a decision at the end of the year.
- ✘ California was home to the largest number (282,794 or 27 percent) of immigrants. For the past 30 years California and five other states have been the primary destinations for legal immigrants. In 2001, California; New York, Florida, Texas, New Jersey, and Illinois attracted about two-thirds of all immigrants.
- ✘ Forty-six percent were born in Latin America/Caribbean and over 40 percent were born in Asia.
- ✘ Seventy-two percent of the immigrants to California came from 10 countries. Thirty-four percent were born in Mexico. The next most prominent sending countries combined contributed another 38 percent of the total immigrants in 2001 (Philippines, China, India, Vietnam, El Salvador, Korea, Taiwan, Guatemala, and Nicaragua).
- ✘ The majority of those who gained legal immigrant status were married. And the majority, 58 percent, was female.
- ✘ The median age was 30.5 years. More than one-quarter of the group was under 21 years old; most were in the working ages; and about 9 percent were 60 years or older.
- ✘ Over 72 percent of the California immigrants were family members of U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents; about 16 percent were admitted based on employment preferences; 5 percent were refugees or asylees; and 7 percent were admitted in other categories.
- ✘ About 64 percent of the 2001 immigrants were already living in the United States (such as temporary workers and students) and adjusted their status with the INS. The remaining immigrants were new arrivals to the country. This is due to a considerable backlog in processing petitions to adjust from a nonimmigrant to immigrant status and represents a notable difference from years before 2000 when most immigrants were new arrivals.
- ✘ Sixty percent of the refugees and asylees settling in California were from Ukraine, Vietnam, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Russia, Iran, and India.
- ✘ One-third of the immigrants settled in Los Angeles County; another one-third lived in Santa Clara, Orange, San Diego, Alameda and Sacramento counties.
