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CALIFORNIA CURRENT POPULATION SURVEY REPORT MARCH 2000-2011 DATA

The Current Population Survey (CPS) conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau for the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) is the primary source of labor force data for the entire nation. Although labor force and unemployment information are central to the CPS, extensive data on the social, economic, and demographic characteristics of the population are also collected through supplemental questions in the Annual Social and Economic Survey (ASEC) each March. Estimates in this report are from the ASEC supplement to the Current Population Survey.

Because the CPS is designed to produce national rather than state-level estimates, the data for states are not as reliable as those for the nation. To improve the precision of estimates for California, data from two consecutive years are combined in this report, and an average is derived (please consult Appendix G of the 2011 March supplement documentation for details on the construction of averages). These estimates, based on two-year averages, are intended to facilitate the examination of changes in the state over time.

DATA LIMITATIONS

The CPS estimation procedure employs independent samples for each state. Sample-weighted results are inflated to independent national estimates of the civilian non-institutional population by age, sex, race, and Hispanic origin. The population estimate for California provided by the CPS is not consistent with population estimates produced by either the U.S. Census Bureau or the California Department of Finance (DOF)¹ because of the unique sample design and weighting procedures. Those sample design and data weighting methods are geared toward producing national estimates, so data for individual states will not be as reliable as national data.

Because the primary purpose of the CPS is to gather labor force data, the sampling procedures used to determine the size of the survey are based on the Coefficient of Variation (CV) of the level of unemployment. This procedure ensures the allocation of a sample large enough to maintain a certain CV level on national monthly estimates of the unemployment level and unemployment rate. As a result, it limits the reliability of demographic information such as age, sex, race/ethnicity, and other variables not closely correlated with labor force variables. All estimates developed from the CPS are subject to sampling error. The magnitude of that error is inversely related to the size of the population being estimated. Estimates for the nation are better (have smaller errors) than those for the state. Estimates for a larger population segment of a state (e.g. total employed) are better than those for a smaller segment (e.g. employment in retail trade). Differences in an estimate over time may be due to sampling error rather than actual change and should be statistically tested. Categories with estimates of 100,000 persons or less are likely to have large standard errors and may be unreliable.

Estimates for a given period may differ from earlier periods not only as a result of changes in real factors or sampling error, but also due to changes in survey and question design. Beginning in 2002, CPS estimates are based on 2000 census-based population controls. **Tabulations contained in this report do not yet reflect Census 2010 results.** From 1994 to 2001, population controls were based on 1990 census data, making comparability to 2002 and subsequent years difficult. According to the Census Bureau, such data control differences could be disproportionately greater for certain subpopulation groups than for the total population. The use of summary measures—such as means, medians, and percentages—is recommended.

USER’S NOTES

To assist in determining the reliability and statistical significance of estimate changes, standard errors (S.E.) for all applicable values in each table are provided in a corresponding S.E. table.

Despite the implementation of the expanded sample in 2001, only information from the regular sample was used for 2001 in this report. The 2002 ASEC survey represented the first time an expanded sample was used for the data reported. A sample size increase of approximately 34,500 households nationally for the 2002 ASEC data and subsequent years has improved the overall reliability of the survey and provides better estimates of non-labor force characteristics.

Beginning in 2003, persons have had the option to report more than one race in the CPS. As a result, data on race are directly comparable only from 2003 to the present, not to data from previous years. In 2003, the CPS also introduced the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) based on the Census 2000 industry and

occupation codes. The new classification system affected almost all industry and occupation variables. Differences between the NAICS and SIC (Standard Industrial Classification) systems are detailed in: <http://www.bls.gov/cps/cpsoccind.htm>.

Race/ethnicity tables are constructed using mutually exclusive categories. The response to the Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino origin question was given priority when determining race/ethnicity, resulting in Hispanic and non-Hispanic categories. The non-Hispanic categories presented in Table 1 are:

- White alone, non-Hispanic
- Black alone, non-Hispanic
- Asian alone, non-Hispanic
- Hawaiian/Pacific Islander alone, non-Hispanic
- Other alone and Two or More Races, non-Hispanic

The Hispanic category includes persons of Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino origin who may be of any race. For all tables in this report except Table 1, race/ethnic groups will not add up to the total population because only Non-Hispanic White, Non-Hispanic Black, Non-Hispanic Asian, and Hispanic origin race/ethnicity categories were tabulated due to data reliability concerns.

Appendix A:
Standard Error Methodology Notes for Two-year Average CPS Tables

1. Since total population estimates are controlled independently, a measure for sampling variability is inappropriate. Instances are displayed as a dash (-) in the standard error tables.
2. Standard errors for two-year average estimates are an average of the standard errors for each year's estimate calculated, using the formula:

$$S_x = \sqrt{S_{x_1}^2 + S_{x_2}^2 + 2rS_{x_1}S_{x_2}}$$

Where:

For years 1 and 2, S_{x_1} and S_{x_2} are the standard errors of the estimates x_1 and x_2 , and r is the year-to-year correlation coefficient.

3. Standard errors for each estimate are calculated using guidelines found in Appendix G – Source of the Data and Accuracy of the Estimates for the 2011 Annual Social and Economic Supplement Microdata File (Appendix G 2011) in the Current Population Survey, 2011 Annual Social and Economic (ASEC) Supplement.
4. Year-specific parameters a and b are calculated from the general variance parameters multiplied by the appropriate year factor. Parameters in Table 6se: Labor Force in 2000-01 and 2001-02 are an exception since yearly variance parameters from Appendix G for years 2000, 2001, and 2002 are used. This exception is based on changes to population controls for persons aged 16 and above in the years 2000 to 2002 and to persons aged 0 and above in the years 2003 to 2011.
5. The 2001 basic year factors from Appendix G 2011 are used in calculations where appropriate since estimates for CPS 2001 in this report use data from the March 2001 basic sample.
6. New state-level parameters a_{state} and b_{state} (not including the exception above) are obtained by:
 - If the parameter a is positive, multiplying the state factor from Appendix G 2011 by the variance parameter a , ($a_{state} = DF * a$).

- If the parameter a is negative, the new state-level parameter a_{state} is calculated as follows:

$$a_{state} = \frac{-b_{state}}{Pop_{state}}$$

where Pop_{state} is the state population estimate.

- Multiplying the state factor from Appendix G 2011 by the variance parameter b , ($b_{state} = DF * b$).
7. When calculating new state-level parameter a_{state} , California total population estimates from the CPS are used, except those for Table 6se: Labor Force in 2000-01 and 2001-02, where values from Appendix G of 2000, 2001, and 2002 are used to modify state factors for those years (see note 4).
 8. When calculating two-year values, the CPS year-to-year correlation coefficients for income characteristics (Appendix G 2011) are used for all non-poverty data categories with the exception of Table 3se: Mobility, where no correlation between years is assumed.
 9. When calculating two-year values, the CPS year-to-year correlation coefficients for poverty characteristics are used for Table 8se: Poverty.

Appendix B: Major Changes in the Current Population Survey Since 1985

2006: Sample design based on 2000 census fully complete.

2005: Every ten years, the CPS sample is redesigned to reflect the results of the most recent decennial census. As of March 2005, the sample was in the middle of being redesigned, with about 55 percent of the sample based on the 2000 census and the balance on the 1990 census. In 2005, the substate identifiers were also updated to reflect the most current metropolitan-area definitions using the June 30, 2003, metropolitan core based statistical area definitions.

2004: Population controls were updated to reflect revised estimates of net international migration for 2000 through 2003. This resulted in a decrease in the estimated size of the non-institutionalized civilian population, labor force, and employment levels.

2003: In addition to the name change from Annual Demographic File to Annual Social and Economic Supplement, modifications to existing CPS variables were made and new variables were introduced. In 2003, persons were able to report more than one race. As a result, the old race variables were replaced with new ones. Again beginning this year, CPS began using the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) based on the Census 2000 industry and occupation codes. The new classification system affected all industry and occupation variables.

2002: The 2002 CPS Annual Demographic File (ADF) contained the expanded sample of state estimates of children's health insurance coverage that was implemented in 2001. The expanded sample added about 34,500 households nationwide and 1,231 households for California in 2002. The 2002 ADF also used weights based on Census 2000 population controls, instead of the 1990 population controls used in previous years. Using 2000-based weights affects weighted frequencies, which are noticeable when comparing 2002 to earlier years.

2001: The Census Bureau expanded the sample size to improve state estimates of children's health insurance coverage in the winter of 2001-02. These data were released in autumn of 2002. The original September 2001 sample file was revised because of a weight adjustment. This report contains only data from the original revised sample file released December 2001.

1996: The sample size taken in Los Angeles County was significantly reduced. The March survey for the first time contained a question on self-reported health status of the respondents.

1994: The independent national population controls used for age, sex, race, and Hispanic origin were prepared by projecting forward the population as enumerated in the 1990 decennial census adjusted for the 1990 census undercount. Most estimates in the profile were affected by these changes.

1990: The sample reduction from 1989 was restored.

1989: The sample size for California was reduced by approximately 38 percent.

1985: Controls for the Hispanic population were introduced for the first time. These controls included an estimate of illegal immigrants.
