<b><u>Revenue Source</u></b> Fees collected for certification and application for certificate renewal		
<b><u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u></b> Costs of operation and administration of the radon certification program		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Historical Comments</u></b> Chapter 294, Statutes of 1997 abolished this fund, pursuant with Health & Safety Code section 106805.
