<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Governmental/Other Governmental Cost Funds	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> A depository for fees collected from adoptees who wish to find their birth parents or birth parents who wish to find their natural children.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Social Services/Org 5180		
<b><u>Major Sources</u></b> Fees for requests for information from adoptee or natural parents.		
<b><u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u></b> Administrative costs of the Department of Social Services.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Chapter 1162, Statutes of 1983 provides that the money in the fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.		
<b><u>Historical Comments</u></b> This fund was abolished pursuant to Government Code section 13306(b).
