<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To support export promotional and public relations activities conducted generally and pursuant to this chapter.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Food and Agriculture/Org 8570		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Funds received from private industry sources, marketing order advisory boards, agricultural councils and agricultural commissions as specified.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Funds expended from the account shall be used exclusively for activities which directly benefit the industry sources from which the funds are derived.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Section 58582 of the Food and Agricultural Code provides that the money in the account is continuously appropriated to the director to support export promotional and public relations activities conducted generally and pursuant to this chapter.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 932, Statutes of 1986 created the California Agricultural Export Promotion Account within the Department of Food and Agriculture Fund
