<u>Purpose</u> Chapter 1326, Statutes of 1984 transfers, as of January 1, 1986, the unexpended balance of funds in the California Health Facilities Commission Fund to the General Fund. Special health facility fees collected but not required to meet current year appropriations shall remain in the General Fund and shall be available in succeeding years, for accountability purposes, the Department of Finance, with the concurrence of the State's Controllers Office, established the Health Facilities Licensing Fee Account in the General Fund.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development/Org 4140		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Special health facility fees.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Administration costs relating to health facilities data collection.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Chapter 439 of the Health and Safety code provides that the funds will be available when appropriated by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 415, Statutes of 1995 abolished this fund.
