<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> Domestic Violence Restraining Order Reimbursement Fund		
<b><u>Legal Citation/Authority</u></b> Chapter 132, Statutes of 2010 Penal Code section 1203.097 (a)(5)		
<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Non-Governmental/Trust and Agency-Non-Federal	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> For local assistance; distribution to local law enforcement or other criminal justice agencies for state mandated local costs resulting from notification requirements.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Justice/Org 0820		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fines/fees from defendants in domestic violence crimes.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> This fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded-</b> Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is 1) derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal) and 2) fines and penalties.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund is one of two that replaces Fund 0253 (Domestic Violence Fund) which is abolished effective January 1, 1999. See also Fund 0642 (Domestic Violence Training and Education Fund). The former Penal Code section 1203.097 was added by Chapter 28, Statutes 1993-94 1 <sup>st</sup> Ex Sess. It was then repealed by its own terms January 1, 2010. Chapter 431, Statutes of 2003 re- added Penal Code section 1203.097.
