<b><u>Purpose</u></b> The fund provides money for licensing and registering barbers. The board deposits all money in this fund.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> State Board of Barber Examiners, Department of Consumer Affairs/ Org 1110		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees prescribed by the code relating to the registration and certification of barbers, barbershops, barber colleges and barber instructors.		
<b><u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u></b> Any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to Fund 0069/State Board of Barbering and Cosmetology Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Section 6629 of the Business and Professions Code provides that, "This fund shall be expended in accordance with the law for all necessary and proper expenses in carrying out the provisions of this chapter upon proper claim approved by the board."		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> Always Excluded.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund is abolished effective 7/1/92 pursuant to Chapter 1672, Statutes of 1990.
