<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To pay the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement costs to administer the Electrician Certification Program that tests for minimum standards and competency in accordance with Labor Code section 108 through 108.5.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Industrial Relations/Org 7350		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees collected pursuant to Labor Code section 108 (a) (3).		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 127, Statutes of 2000 originally created this fund under Labor Code section 3099.5. Chapter 46, Statutes of 2012 repealed Labor Code section 3099.5 and added Section 108.5 effective June 27, 2012.
