Santa Barbara County Formation Commission loan (Issue 101)—It is requested that Item 9210-102-0001 be added in order to provide a \$400,000 General Fund loan to Santa Barbara County to fund its required duties associated with the proposed formation of a new county (Mission County). A petition to initiate the formation of Mission County has garnered the necessary signatures, and once this occurs, the Governor is statutorily required to appoint a five-member County Formation Review Commission to study the proposal. Santa Barbara County has indicated the costs associated with the Commission's study to be approximately \$400,000. Statute authorizes such loans, however, the maximum loan amount is \$100,000. Trailer bill language will be introduced to abolish the current revolving fund, increase the maximum loan from \$100,000 to \$400,000 and allow the State Controller to reduce the recipient county's Homeowners Property Tax subvention if the loan is not repaid. Repayment of the loan (with interest) will be due one year from when the issue of county formation is voted on by the people in Santa Barbara County.

County Formation Commission Loans

Section 1. Amend Government Code Section 23344 as follows:

- 23344. (a) The commission may borrow such moneys as may be necessary to meet its expenses until the costs of the commission have been determined pursuant to the provisions of Section 23343.
- (b) As an alternative to the procedure authorized by subdivision (a), the commission may request the State Controller, upon appropriation from the General Fund, and the State Controller shall loan from the County Formation Revolving Fund such moneys as the commission shall determine necessary to meet its expenses until the costs have been determined pursuant to the provisions of Section 23343. Such loan shall be at an interest rate equal to that of the Pooled Money Investment Fund at the time the loan is made.
- (c) Loans made pursuant to this section shall not exceed a total of one four hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000 \$400,000) for each commission, and shall be repaid within one year of the date on which the issue of county formation was voted on by the people.
- (d) The sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) shall be transferred from the General Fund to the County Formation Revolving Fund, which is hereby created, and is hereby appropriated, without regard to fiscal years, for purposes of this section. An additional sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) shall be transferred from the General Fund to the County Formation Revolving Fund on the effective date of the act amending this section during the 1977-78 Regular Session, and is hereby appropriated without regard to fiscal years for purposes of this section. The additional sum thus appropriated may be expended for any ebligation incurred by any commission at any time. Any repayments on loans made pursuant to this section, including interest, received by the State Controller shall be deposited in the County Formation Revolving General Fund.
- (e) If the loans made pursuant to this section are not repaid, the State Controller is authorized to reduce the monies allocated to the county to whom the loan was made by an amount equal to the amount that is due to the State. This reduction shall be made from the subventions made pursuant to Government Code Sections 16100 and 16120.

Provisions:

- 1. For allocation by the State Controller to the Santa Barbara County Formation Commission pursuant to Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 23331) of Division 1 of Title 3 of the Government Code.
