Addition of Trailer Bill Language, Capital Outlay, California State University

It is requested that trailer bill language be added to authorize California State University (CSU) to apply remaining proceeds from its share of four General Obligations bonds towards the CSU Los Angeles: Physical Sciences Building Renovation project (see Attachment 1). The specific proceeds are from the 1996 University Capital Outlay Bond Fund, 2002 Higher Education Capital Outlay Bond Fund, 2004 Higher Education Capital Outlay Bond Fund, and 2006 University Capital Outlay Bond Fund. In total, these bonds would provide approximately \$11 million of an estimated \$40 million renovation project to address fire life safety and code deficiencies at the facility, including outdated elevators and inadequate fire alarm and suppression systems.
