Amendment to Budget Bill Item 6870-301-6087 and Addition of Items 6870-492 and 6870-493, Capital Outlay, Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges

It is requested that Item 6870-301-6087 be increased by \$197,108,000 in Proposition 51 General Obligations Bonds (see Attachment 1). Of this total, \$196,568,000 will provide construction authority for 14 projects. These projects are scheduled to complete working drawings in fiscal year 2021-22. The remaining \$540,000 is a supplemental appropriation to fully fund the preliminary plans and working drawings phase of the Riverside Community College District, Norco College: Center for Human Performance and Kinesiology project. While the Administration proposes to fund the entirety of the design phases with Proposition 51 funding for this project, it is expected that for the construction phase, the district will provide a local match equal to at least 20 percent of overall project costs.

It is further requested that Items 6870-492 and 6870-493 be added to reappropriate authority for 12 projects (4 construction and 8 working drawings) to ensure districts can proceed with their respective phases without delay, and to extend the liquidation period for one project (see Attachments 2 and 3).
