



All other individuals holding designated positions ~~shall~~ must file their statements with the **Department**. All statements must be made available for public inspection and reproduction ~~(Gov. Code Sec. 81008)~~ under Government Code Section 81008.

Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's or new position's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Director of Finance's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code. (Gov. Code Sec. 81008.)

APPENDIX B

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

Category ICategory I

Designated employees positions in this category shall disclose all investments, and business positions in business entities, sources of income (including receipt of interests in real property, income including gifts, loans, and travel payments), and business positions, and real property located in the state of California.

Category IICategory II

Designated employees positions in this category shall disclose:

- Any business entity in which the designated employee has an investment or business position, or income Investments and business positions in business entities, and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans, and travel payments), if the business entity or source of income is of the type which has sold or leased services, supplies, products, or equipment to any department, board, commission, or any other agency within the employee's position's assigned program area, within the period covered by the disclosure statement.
- Any business entity in which the designated employee has an investment or business position, or income including Investments and business positions in business entities, and sources of income, (including receipt of gifts, loans, and travel payments), if the business entity or source of income is regulated by the programs of any department, board, commission, or other agency within the employee's position's assigned program area.
- Any All interests in real property which is owned, leased, or otherwise subject to a beneficial or ownership interest by any department, board, commission, or agency within the employee's position's assigned program area, or which is directly subject to regulation or of the type to receive grants or other monies from or through the department, board, commission, or other agency.

Category IIICategory III

DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

Designated employees positions in this category shall disclose business entities in which they have investments or business positions, or income including gifts, loans, and travel payments, if the business entity or source of income is of the type which sells or leases telecommunication, information technology, electronic data processing products, facilities, supplies or services. investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans and travel payments) if the business entity or source provides information technology or telecommunications goods, products or services including computer hardware or software companies, computer consultant services, IT training companies, data processing firms and media services.

Category IVCategory IV

Designated employees positions in this category shall disclose investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans, and travel payments) if the business entity or source provides in which they have investments or business positions, or income including gifts, loans, and travel payments, if the business entity or source of income is of the type which sells or leases electronic and other accounting goods products and services (including training or consulting services).

Category VCategory V

Designated employees positions in this category shall disclose investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans and travel payments) if the business entity or source in which they have investments or business positions, or income including gifts, loans, and travel payments, if the business entity or source of income provides products, data collection or consulting services, field survey services or information, economic and revenue data and forecasting, or applications and use of electronic data processing.

Category XCategory X

Designated positions in this category shall indicate whether, during the reporting period they had a financial interest in any of their assignments. If they had no such interest, they shall file Fair Political Practices Commission Form 700-A. Otherwise, they shall disclose their pertinent financial interests in any of their assignments on the schedules for Fair Political Practices Commission Form 700.
