This profile presents data from the 2020 Census Redistricting (Public Law 94-171) File published by the U.S. Census Bureau. Specifically, it contains total population and population 18 years and older by race (Not Hispanic/Latino) and Hispanic/Latino; total housing units, households (occupied units), vacant units; and population by type of group quarters for the selected geographic area(s).

DATA NOTES:

Race/Hispanic Concepts:

Data on race were derived from answers to the 2020 Census question on race that was asked of all people. These data are based on self-identification. The racial categories included in the census questionnaire generally reflect a social definition of race recognized in this country and not an attempt to define race biologically, anthropologically, or genetically.

Data on the Hispanic or Latino population were derived from answers to a question that was asked of all people. **People who identify as Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish may be of any race.** Tabulations in this profile present the Hispanic/Latino population alongside race categories that exclude Hispanics/Latinos. The tabulations will sum to the total and to 100 percent when the Hispanic/Latino group is added to the not Hispanic/Latino race categories.

Group Quarters:

Group quarters are places where people live or stay in a group living arrangement that are owned or managed by an entity or organization providing housing and/or services for the residents. These services may include custodial or medical care as well as other types of assistance, and residency is commonly restricted to those receiving these services. This is not a typical household-type living arrangement. People living in group quarters are usually not related to each other.

Group quarters include such places as college residence halls, residential treatment centers, skilled-nursing facilities, group homes, military barracks, correctional facilities, and workers' dormitories.

Geographic Notes:

All geographic areas are based on boundaries as of January 1, 2020.

A "Census Designated Place" (CDP) is a statistical counterpart of incorporated places. They are not legally incorporated. The boundaries are defined in cooperation with local officials and generally updated prior to each decennial census. A CDP with the same name in an earlier census does not necessarily have the same boundary in later censuses. A CDP may cross county boundaries. If shown with a county name, the user can assume the data represent only that part of the CDP within the designated county.

Differential Privacy and Calculated Variables

The U.S. Census Bureau does not recommend creating variables that mix 2020 Census housing and population data, such as persons per household, due to the use of separate differential privacy processing algorithms.
