Census Bureau data used in California counties' population estimates were not available in time for the December 19, 2025 release of the July 2025 state and county estimates due to the U.S. government shutdown. The delayed data became available in January 2026. July 2025 population estimates have been updated to reflect changes in the county-level estimates.

Notable for this February 2026 data release:

- The release maintains the same state population totals for July 2020 to July 2025, as estimates at the state level were unchanged.
- County population estimates are revised from 2020 to 2025 due to updated data availability from the U.S. Census Bureau.

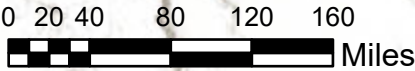
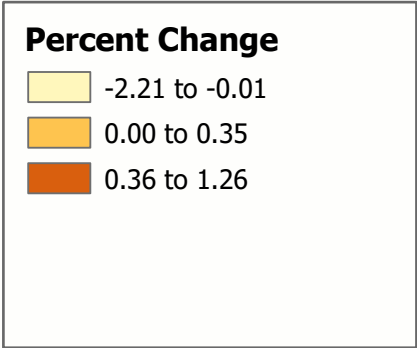
July 1, 2025 Population Estimates County Percentage of California's Population

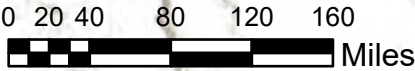
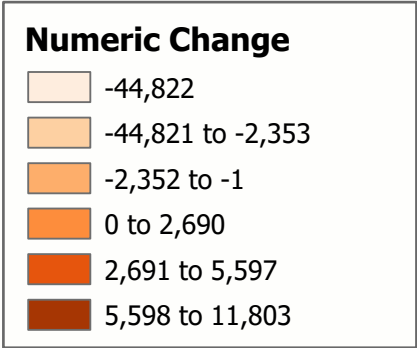

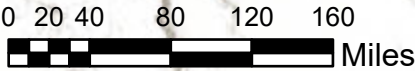

Natural Increase

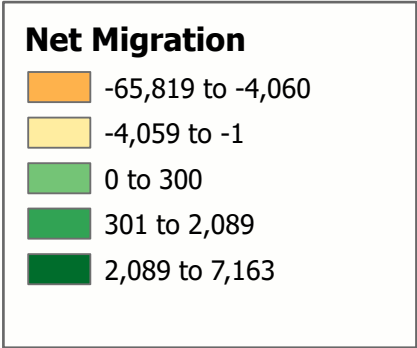

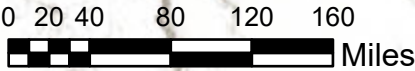

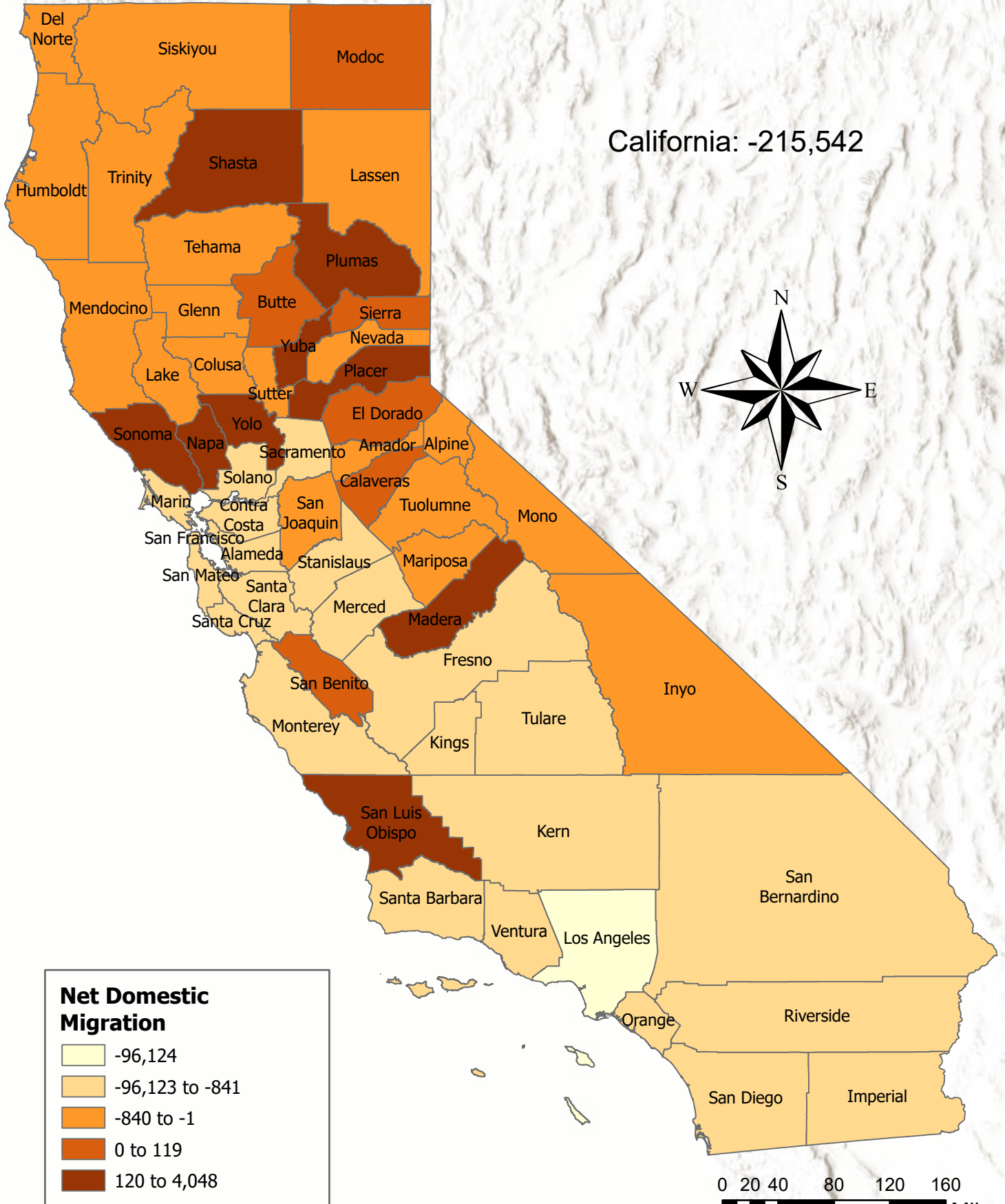

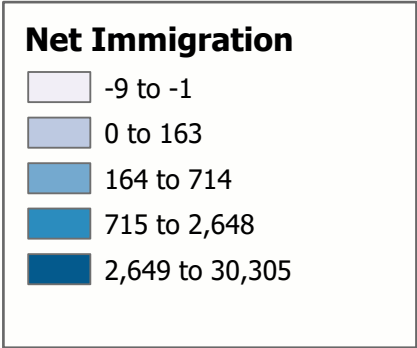

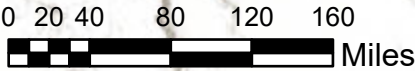
