



STATE'S RETURN TO POSITIVE POPULATION GROWTH CONTINUES
WITH 49,000 INCREASE IN FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024

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SACRAMENTO—Marking a second 12-month period of positive growth, California's population grew by roughly 49,000 in the fiscal year ending July 1st to 39,172,742 according to new data released today by the California Department of Finance.

The growth over the period reflects a combination of several factors:

- Legal immigration continued to rebound from the pandemic, with a net gain of 134,400 persons in 2023-24 compared to 115,900 in 2022-23—the highest level since 2018.
- Greater domestic in-migration and slowed domestic out-migration helped to bring net loss in domestic migration down to below 200,000 persons in 2023-24 from nearly 250,000 persons in 2022-23. Net domestic migration from California in 2023-2024 dropped significantly – to about one-sixth of the 2021 total – and is similar to levels prior to 2018.
- Natural increase—the net result of births minus deaths—increased from 107,400 in 2022-23 to 111,500 in 2023-24 as the number of deaths return to trend from their pandemic peak.

Net international legal migration to California reached 134,400 people in the year ending July 2024, a significant factor in overall growth. With increasing international migration and deaths returning to long-term trends, a stable foundation for growth continues. California is likely to experience gradual but positive growth for the near future as net domestic migration is expected to recede to the lower rates of the 2010s.

The department's latest estimate is in line with just-released population data for the same period by the U.S. Census Bureau, which showed a higher growth rate of 233,000. The principal difference between the two estimates is a larger level of international legal migration to California reflected in the Census Bureau data.

Other highlights of the July 1, 2024, county population report include:

- California's 58 counties range in size from Alpine County, with just over 1,160 residents, to Los Angeles County with 9.8 million residents. The population increased in 30 counties, with most growth in the Central Valley, the Inland Empire, and coastal counties. Population gains reflect natural increase exceeding losses in net migration. Only Placer, Yolo, Yuba, and Glenn counties had positive population growth from natural increase, net international migration, and net domestic migration.
- The state's ten largest counties remain Los Angeles, San Diego, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, Santa Clara, Alameda, Sacramento, Contra Costa, and Fresno, with each having more than one million residents. These ten counties represent 72 percent of

California's population. Nine of the ten counties with one million or more people have positive population growth, leaving Contra Costa as the only county with population loss. Los Angeles led with an increase of 11,300 persons.

- Population growth rates ranged from a high of 1.09 percent in Del Norte County to a low of -1.23 percent in Plumas County. The next fastest-growing counties in terms of percentage growth were Imperial (0.95 percent), Yuba (0.66 percent), Merced (0.61 percent), Placer (0.58 percent), and Madera (0.56 percent).
- Although natural increase was a main source of population growth in the state, 24 counties experienced natural decrease—more deaths than births. Among those counties, natural decrease in Butte, Del Norte, Lake, and Shasta counties was offset by positive net migration, especially net domestic migration.

Background Information

Population estimates produced by the California Department of Finance are mandated by the California Constitution and various codes. Estimates are used by state agencies, California counties, academic institutions, private research organizations, the media, and the public. Primary uses include budgeting, needs assessment, program planning and evaluation, distribution of state funds, and the calculation of rates (such as birth, death, and incarceration).

The California Department of Finance estimates population each year based on changes in births, deaths, domestic migration, and international migration. Estimates are developed using aggregate data from a variety of sources, including birth and death counts provided by the Department of Public Health, driver's license data from the Department of Motor Vehicles, housing unit data from local governments, school enrollment data from the Department of Education, and federal income tax return data from the U.S. Internal Revenue Service. These statistical reports of administrative records do not disclose any information about individuals.





July 1, 2024 Population Estimates County Percentage of California's Population










