The Replacement Tire Efficiency Program, codified at Public Resources Code sections 25770-25773, amended the Warren-Alquist Act and directs the CEC to develop and maintain a database for tire efficiency information, develop an efficient tire rating system, require reporting of tire efficiency data from tire manufacturers, establish minimum standards for the fuel efficiency of replacement tires, develop an efficient tire consumer information program, and related activities. The proposed regulation will also increase the withholding tax rate from the flat 7 percent tax rate to the highest marginal tax rate, as well as add a safe harbor from the imposition of an information return penalty on an upper tier pass-through entity that certifies the late-filed Form 592-PTE is filed within 30 days of receiving a Form 592-B.
