Brief summary of the proposed regulation (1 paragraph or less): The proposed changes will align the regulations with changes from Senate Bill 833, which updated California Welfare and Institutions Code Section 14009.5. The changes limit DHCS' Estate Recovery (ER) program to the federally-mandated minimum. The regulations will limit ER solely to those services required by federal law (nursing facility services, home and community-based services, and related hospital and prescription drug services), limit ER to probated estates, eliminate ER for deceased Medi-Cal members that are survived by a spouse or registered domestic partner, add a hardship waiver criterion for homesteads of modest value, and change the interest rate for voluntary post death liens.
