The certification systems include in-station diagnostics (ISD) similar to on-board diagnostic systems on cars that provide warning to gas station operators when there is a high likelihood of vapor recovery equipment failures so that repairs can be carried out expeditiously. Staff will propose a number of station and vehicle specific solutions to address ISD nuisance overpressure alarms that are experienced by GDFs primarily during periods when winter gasoline is sold (typically between November and March). The proposed emission control system warranty amendments would lengthen the existing warranty periods to better reflect the longevity and usage of modern trucks, thus ensuring that any defects that cause engines or vehicles to fail to conform to applicable requirements are repaired at no additional cost to the consumer. The proposed emissions warranty information reporting amendments would require manufacturers to take corrective action (typically in the form of a recall or extended warranty) once the warranty claims rate for an emission control component exceeds the corrective action threshold, thus ensuring that any components with systemic failures are repaired timely and at no additional cost to the customer. The regulations will limit ER solely to those services required by federal law (nursing facility services, home and community-based services, and related hospital and prescription drug services), limit ER to probated estates, eliminate ER for deceased Medi-Cal members that are survived by a spouse or registered domestic partner, add a hardship waiver criterion for homesteads of modest value, and change the interest rate for voluntary post death liens.
