- 5. What could go wrong in meeting a particular goal or objective, or critical function?
- 6. How could we fail?
- 7. What must go right for us to succeed and complete our mission?
- 8. Do we have liquid assets or assets with alternative uses?
- 9. How could someone steal from this department?
- 10. How do we know we are achieving our objectives?
- 11. On what information do we most rely?
- 12. On what do we spend the most money?
- 13. What decisions require the most judgment?
- 14. How do we know we are collecting all of our revenue or accounts receivable?
- 15. What is our greatest legal exposure?
- 16. How could we lose credibility with control agencies, the Legislature, the public?
- 17. Do we have updated written polices and procedures for all major duties?
- 18. What are the most critical records or data files at our department? How is access controlled?
- 19. What would be the impact if the data was lost or destroyed?
- 20. What would be the impact if we could not access this building for two weeks because of a fire, chemical spill?
