



**Legal Immigration to California in 2002**


This report highlights attributes of immigrants granted legal permanent residence in 2002 by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services, formerly the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS). A more complete analysis of recent immigrants is included in a prior report: *They Came to California: Legal Immigration in 2000*.

Highlights of the 2002 Data:

- ✖ As in 2001, the United States became home to more than one million immigrants in 2002. Thirty-six percent of the immigrants were new arrivals to this country. The remaining sixty-four percent of the immigrants granted legal permanent residence had been in the country an average of three to four years. The backlog in processing "adjustment of status" applications persisted. Nearly a million cases were still pending a decision at the end of the year.
- ✖ The majority of immigrants, especially in California, were admitted to join family members in this country. In California 72 percent of the immigrants were family-sponsored, 15 percent were admitted based on employment preferences, 5 percent were refugees or asylees, and 8 percent were admitted in other categories.




- ✖ California was home to the largest number (291,191 or 27.4 percent) of the 2002 immigrants. For the past three decades California, New York, Florida, Texas, New Jersey, and Illinois have been the primary destinations for legal immigrants. In 2002, these six states attracted nearly two-thirds of all immigrants. California attracted as many immigrants as New York, Florida and Texas combined.



- ✖ Forty-nine percent of the State's 2002 immigrants were born in Latin America and the Caribbean, primarily Mexico, and almost 40 percent were born in Asia.


- Three-fourths of the 2002 immigrants to California came from 10 countries. Thirty-six percent were born in Mexico. The remaining nine most prominent sending countries combined contributed 39 percent of the total immigrants (Philippines, People's Republic of China, India, El Salvador, Vietnam, Guatemala, Iran, Korea, and Taiwan). Iran replaced Nicaragua in the list of top ten sending countries.

Top Ten Sending Countries



- Almost two-thirds of those who gained legal immigrant status were married. The majority, 56 percent, of immigrants was female.
- The median age of the immigrants was 30.4 years. Half of the group was between 20 and 40 years old.

- Nearly two-thirds of the refugees and asylees settling in California were from Iran, Ukraine, Vietnam, India, Russia, and Bosnia-Herzegovina.
- Thirty-seven percent of the immigrants settled in Los Angeles County; thirty-five percent resided in Santa Clara, Orange, San Diego, Alameda and San Bernardino counties.
