Amendment to Budget Bill Items 3940-001-0001, 3940-001-0225, and 3940-001-0439, Support, State Water Resources Control Board

Pacific Lumber Company Litigation Defense

It is requested that Item 3940-001-0001 be increased by \$2,676,000 and that Item 3940-001-0439 be amended to reflect this change to provide funding to defend the State of California from a lawsuit filed by the Pacific Lumber Company. The defense costs for this ongoing litigation have increased as the case has entered active discovery and will be set for trial soon.

Aboveground Petroleum Storage Act Oversight

It is requested that Item 3940-001-0225 be added in the amount of \$577,000 and that Item 3940-001-0439 be amended to reflect this change to provide funding to the Certified Unified Program Agencies (CUPAs). The appropriation is consistent with the provisions of Chapter 626, Statutes of 2007 (AB 1130). AB 1130 transferred the administration of the Aboveground Storage Tank Inspection Program from the State Water Resources Control Board (Water Board) to the CUPAs and allocated the balance of the Environmental Protection Trust Fund (EPTF) for program implementation. The Water Board has allocated \$7.5 million EPTF to the CUPAs, but there is a fund balance of \$577,000 due to additional earned interest.

Administration Water Rights Enforcement

It is requested that Item 3940-001-0439 be amended to increase the appropriation for 30.01 Administration by \$173,000 and decrease the appropriation for 30.02 Distributed Administration by \$173,000. Chapter 2, Statutes of 2009, Seventh Extraordinary Session (SB X7 8) appropriated funds and positions to the Water Board for Water Rights enforcement and increased the allocation for Administration. The proposed Governor's Budget submitted on January 8, 2010, did not correctly reflect the bill's impact to the Water Board's Administration budget. These technical adjustments do not result in a change in the total appropriation for Item 3940-001-0439.
