**Amendment to Budget Bill Items 8570-001-0001 and 8570-001-0890, Support, California
Department of Food and Agriculture**

**Amendment to Budget Bill Items 8660-003-0412, 8660-003-0461, and 8660-003-0462,
Support, California Public Utilities Commission**

It is requested that Items 8660-003-0412 and 8660-003-0461 be eliminated and Item 8660-003-0462 be increased by \$712,000 to appropriately align lease revenue bond payments with the programs housed in the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC's) main headquarters building. Upon completion of the relocation of the Consumer Protection and Safety Division (CPSD) to a nearby building by the end of the current fiscal year, there will be no CPSD staff in the CPUC's headquarters. As such, lease revenue costs at the headquarters building should no longer be paid by the Transportation Rate Fund (Item 8660-003-0412) or the Public Utilities Commission Transportation Reimbursement Account (Item 8660-003-0461). Instead, all lease revenue costs will be paid from the Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account (Item 8660-003-0462).

Addition of Budget Bill Item 8790-001-0001, Support, California Commission on Disability Access

Addition of Budget Bill Item 9350-490, Reappropriation, Shared Revenues for Support of Local Streets and Road Improvement, Congestion Relief, Traffic Safety Account of 2006, Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Fund of 2006

It is requested that Item 9350-490 be added to reappropriate the unallocated balances of funding appropriated in the 2007 and 2009 Budget Acts from the Proposition 1B Local Streets and Road Improvement, Congestion Relief, Traffic Safety Account of 2006. This will allow the State Controller's Office to allocate funding to cities and counties for local road maintenance and rehabilitation projects. The specific language is proposed as follows:

9350-490—Reappropriation, Local Assistance, Shared Revenues for support of Local Streets and Road Improvement, Congestion Relief, Traffic Safety Account of 2006, Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Fund of 2006. The amounts specified in the following citations are reappropriated for the purposes provided for in the appropriations and are available for encumbrance or allocation until June 30, 2011.

6065—Local Streets and Road Improvement, Congestion Relief, and Traffic Safety Account of 2006, Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Fund of 2006.

(1) Item 9350-104-6065, Budget Act of 2007 (Chs. 171 and 172, Stats. 2007).

(2) Item 9350-104-6065, Budget Act of 2009 (Ch. 1, Stats. 2009, Third Extraordinary Session).

Addition of Budget Bill Control Section 15.45

It is requested that Control Section 15.45 be added to the Budget Bill. The purpose is to create a mechanism, identical to that contained in the 2009 Budget Act, for the State Controller's Office to offset General Fund expenditures with \$350 million in tax increment revenues that will be received from redevelopment agencies in 2010-11 pursuant to Assembly Bill 26, Fourth Extraordinary Session (Chapter 21, Statutes of 2009).

The proposed language is as follows:

SEC. 15.45. (a) The Controller shall offset General Fund expenditures with any funds received from county offices of education for state program costs, other than costs of trial courts, pursuant to Section 99081 of the Government Code. These offsets shall be recorded as a reduction of total expenditures for each agency under which the state program expenditures occur and shall not be a reduction to any department or program budget item. The Director of Finance shall identify the specific non-Budget Act items against which to record the payments.

(b) The Controller shall offset payments to the Trial Court Trust Fund from Item 0250-111-0001 of Section 2.00 with any funds received from county offices of education for reimbursement of trial court costs pursuant to Section 99081 of the Government Code.
