**Amendment to Budget Bill Item 5225-001-0001, Support, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation**

**Armstrong Accessibility Improvements (Issue 240)**—It is requested that Item 5225-001-0001 be increased by \$17.5 million on a one-time basis in fiscal year 2014-15 to make physical plant improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility guidelines. Of the amount requested, \$13.5 million will be used for construction at four institutions and \$4 million will be used to develop design plans for 15 institutions.

**Parole Revocation and Court Compliance Workload (Issue 280)**—It is requested that Item 5225-001-0001 be increased by \$5,191,000 and 36 positions beginning in 2014-15 to continue addressing parole revocation and court compliance workload. This adjustment continues the use of court agents for the parole revocation process and the notice-of-charges and accommodations-interviewing workload for parolees pending revocation in county jails.

**California Sex Offender Management Board and the State Authorized Risk Assessment Tools for Sex Offenders Review Committee (Issue 282)**—It is requested that Item 5225-001-0001 be increased by \$311,000 and 2 positions on a two-year limited-term basis to meet the workload and training requirements imposed by Chelsea's Law (Chapter 219, Statutes of 2010).

5227-401—Notwithstanding Provision 3 of Item 5225-105-001, Budget Act of 2011 (Ch. 33, Stats. 2011) and Provision 2 of Item 5227-105-0001, Budget Act of 2012 (Chs. 21 and 29, Stats. 2012) funds provided to the California Counties Foundation, Chief Probation Officers of California Foundation, and California State Sheriffs Association Foundation for the purpose of continuing to provide statewide training to counties on implementing Chapter 15, Statutes of 2011 (AB 109) shall be available for expenditure only until June 30, 2018. Any moneys not expended on or before that date shall be returned by those foundations to the state for deposit into the General Fund.
