Amendment to Budget Bill Items 5225-001-0001 and 5225-002-0001, Support, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation

Inmate Complaint Review Process—It is requested that Item 5225-001-0001 be increased by \$9,803,000 and 47 positions to establish regional units within the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's Office of Internal Affairs to review and conduct inquiries regarding inmate complaints of staff misconduct. This proposal is the Department's response to a recent audit by the Office of the Inspector General which identified deficiencies in the staff complaint review process at Salinas Valley State Prison.

Contract Medical Services—It is requested that Item 5225-002-0001 be increased by \$61.9 million for California Correctional Health Care Services contract medical services. The one-time augmentation alleviates pressure in the contract medical services budget while allowing California Correctional Health Care Services to determine an alternative funding methodology for future fiscal years.

Lease Augmentation—It is requested that Item 5225-002-0001 be increased by \$3.6 million to provide funding for increased lease costs at various California Correctional Health Care Services office buildings. The Department is unable to absorb the increased costs within their existing budget.

Technical Adjustments—It is requested that Item 5225-001-0001 be decreased by \$1,174,000 and increased by 2.4 positions to reflect various technical adjustments to correctly align resources. These adjustments include a reduction of funding associated with the Division of Juvenile Justice's California Volunteers proposal, a correction of one-time funds erroneously budgeted as ongoing, and the addition of necessary positions to support the 7-day week operations at the Ventura Training Center.

Amendment to Budget Bill Items 5225-301-0001 and 5225-491, Capital Outlay, Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation

San Quentin State Prison, San Quentin: New Boiler Facility (Issue 301)—It is requested that Item 5225-301-0001 be increased by \$27,268,000 to reflect addition of the construction appropriation for this project. Replacement of the boiler is required for compliance with Bay Area Air Quality Management District standards.

Pelican Bay State Prison: Classroom Space (Issue 303)—It is requested that Item 5225-491 be amended to reappropriate the working drawings and construction phases of this project. Working drawings are not expected to be completed during fiscal year 2018-19. This reappropriation is necessary to keep funding available for the bid process and for construction in the budget year. Working drawings are estimated to be completed in July 2019 and construction is estimated to be completed October 2020 (see Attachment 1).

Pelican Bay State Prison: Fire Suppression Upgrade (Issue 304)—It is requested that Item 5225-491 be amended to reappropriate the working drawings phase of this project. Due to delays completing preliminary plans, working drawings are not anticipated to be completed during 2018-19. This reappropriation is necessary to keep funding available for the working drawings phase in the budget year. Working drawings are estimated to be completed in July 2020 and construction is estimated to be completed March 2022 (see Attachment 1).
